- We will be using recorded accompaniment for the auditions. An accompanist will not be available.
- Karaoke tracks can be downloaded from many on line sites.
- Another source is to have your vocal instructor or a musician record the accompaniment.
- New actors who do not have experience with auditions and are not auditioning for a Lead Role may sing Happy Birthday.
- Plan to sing 16-32 measures of music maximum length of time is 1 minute.

Costumes

- Most costumes will be provided however the costumer may ask if cast members are able to provide certain items such as a white dress shirt that they already have.
- Cast members will be expected to provide appropriate shoes, socks, or tights and undergarments such as a leotard for female cast members and T shirts & bike shorts for male cast members.

Rehearsals

• Rehearsals will typically be on Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday in the 4-8pm time frame. Rehearsals will be longer and later in the evening during Tech and Dress rehearsals. Dress rehearsals will be 6-10pm.

- Additional rehearsals (including Saturday rehearsals) will be scheduled as needed.
 - Not all cast members will be called to every rehearsal prior to Tech and Dress Rehearsals.
- All rehearsals and performances will be at the Historic Finnish Temperance Hall

Performances

- We proudly double cast many or all roles in our shows as this allows more cast members to develop their performance skills.
- We will offer two school field trip shows to local students, many of which have never had a chance to see a show at a "real theatre."
 - These shows would be on a school day between the weekends that the show runs.
 - In order to schedule these shows, we need to know if your child will be available to perform in one or both of the shows.
 - Missing school for field trip performances is an excused absence. We will provide a letter about the field trip performance for each cast member to give to their school.

Volunteer Hours

- We cannot offer our Youth Mainstage Workshops at affordable rates without the help of cast family members.
- Please be prepared to donate at least 15 hours of volunteer time during the workshop.
- Volunteer tasks include stagehand / back stage assistance, chaperoning cast members during rehearsals or when they are not on stage during the show, set building, set painting, working in the snack bar, selling tickets, sewing costumes. There are tasks available for all skill levels!
- For those whose work or family schedules preclude volunteering in person, donations for our snack bar, such as bottled water, sodas, etc., may be arranged.
